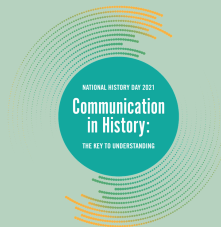

### SCHOOL HISTORY DAY FAIRS

#### DEC 2020-FEB 2021

Groups are limited to 3 students maximum.

#### Youth Categories (grades 4-5):

- Essay – up to 5 per school per division
- Display – up to 8 per school division
- Performance – up to 5 per school division
- Documentary – up to 5 per school division
- Website – up to 5 per school division
- 'Ōlelo Hawai'i - up to 5 per school division

#### Junior (grades 6-8) & Senior Categories (grades 9-12):

- Essay – up to 8 per school per division
- Display – up to 8 per school per division or 8% if over 100
- Performance – up to 8 per school per division
- Documentary – up to 8 per school per division
- Website – up to 8 per school per division or 8% if over 100
- 'Ōlelo Hawai'i - up to 8 per school per division

*(School fairs should not be held after Feb 1, 2020)*

*'Ōlelo Hawai'i projects and youth category projects can advance up to State level only.*
