2022 SCHOOL HISTORY DAY FAIRS (DEC.-FEB.) **In-Person*

DEC. 2021-FEB. 1, 2022

(School fairs should not be held after FEB. 1, 2021)
Youth category projects and 'Ōlelo Hawai'i projects can only advance to the State level.

Groups are limited to 3 students maximum.

Youth Division (grades 4-5):

- Essay – up to 5 per school per division
- Display – up to 8 per school per division
- Performance – up to 5 per school per division
- Documentary – up to 5 per school per division
- Website – up to 5 per school per division
- 'Ōlelo Hawai'i – up to 5 per school per division

Junior (grades 6-8) and Senior Divisions (grades 9-12):

- Essay – up to 8 per school per division
- Display – up to 8 per school per division or 8% if over 100
- Performance – up to 8 per school per division
- Documentary – up to 8 per school per division
- Website – up to 8 per school per division or 8% if over 100
- 'Ōlelo Hawai'i – up to 8 per school per division
